

The testimony of Pastor Moses Muguro

Pastor Moses is today a dynamic pastor, preacher, evangelist and loving husband and father.. He was born in a slum in Kenya. He and his twin brother were the seventh and eighth children born to their mother and father. Both of the twin boys were born with epilepsy.

To be born in a slum in Africa is about as disadvantaged and hopeless as a child's circumstance could be. The fact that Moses' father was also an alcoholic made life virtually hopeless. No one came with money or offering an opportunity for advancement. No one came with cleaner water or better food, but someone did come with the true message of Jesus and led Moses' father to the Lord. When Jesus is presented as He truly is--Lord and Savior, and when He is received as Lord and Savior by any person; Jesus Himself enters that persons life and actually dwells there by His Holy Spirit. There inside the spirit and soul and body of that man, woman or child; God is now..."in you to will and to do for His good pleasure". Life if going to change.

Moses' father became a sober man, no longer a drunkard. He took his family with him to church and learned the ways of the Lord. His two little boys were epileptics.. They were plagued with seizures, but there father learned that all true believers in Jesus can..."lay hands on the sick and they shall recover". So, he put his hands on the heads of his two precious little boys and prayed for the Lord to deliver them from their affliction. Something like the "sound of wind" went rushing out of their impoverished dwelling and, since that moment, neither of the boys has had another seizure.

Moses father became a pastor. Moses and his twin brother are both college-educated and successful pastors. All of Moses' siblings are in the ministry. Life for this family was completely altered and the destiny of thousands of people in future generations was drastically changed by introducing Jesus Christ to one needy man.

There is a need for better water, better food, better medicine, better education and better living conditions throughout most of the world. But changing the outward circumstances can do just so much. When the Creator of the universe is invited into the life of a human being, that human being, who was created in God's express image, can now become what the Creator intended.

The very hand of God can be seen in the life of Moses Muguro and his beautiful wife, Esther and their children, Gloria and Wisdom. Esther will soon receive her masters degree in public health from Tulane University in New Orleans because of a grant from the Ford Foundation. She is a public health official in Nairobi and speaks widely to hundreds of people each month about abstinence and self control to curb the spread of aids in Kenya. She skillfully uses this open door as an opportunity to tell large crowds of youth and adults about the life-changing

power of God. Moses is a pastor with the All Nations Churches in Kenya and has seen great success in his ministry as a pastor. He is also the director of The Sword of The Lord Club in Africa. Working with hundreds of club sponsors, teachers, pastors and officials, Pastor Moses has established 420 clubs to date in churches and private schools and in the public schools as well. A conservative estimate indicates over 20,000 children now active in the Sword of The Lord Clubs in Africa.

Tens of thousands of young people from six years old through the early teens being led to receive Jesus Christ as their own personal Savior and Lord and then being trained to know and apply the Word of God to change their lives and the lives of all the people around them for generations to come. In three short years starting from the first club, the growth has been phenomenal and the momentum is increasing every day.
